
There was a little confusion in the letter that went home regarding the music event next Friday for Class 3. The event is being held at Budehaven Community Hall and starts at 5.30.



This week saw an increase in our FunFit numbers which is fantastic. We would like to remind you of the 2 for 1 offer that we have on, If you buy a pass for one of the sessions you can attend the other session for free. As there are now only 5 weeks remaining until Easter A pass for the rest of the term will cost £12.50 per child or a family pass for 2 or more children for £25. FunFit runs in the hall from 8am Tuesday and Thursdays.

FunFit is a programme which aims to improve motor co-ordination and underlying postural stability and balance in children. Activities will also help to improve eye-hand co-ordination, body awareness, spatial awareness and ball skills. The activities are based on typical motor skill development. They have been chosen to help improve the first and second stages of motor skill development i.e. foundations of movement skills particularly postural control and co-ordinating both sides of the body together, and the fundamental movement skills including jumping, hopping, skipping, balancing which together provide a foundation on which fine motor skills can develop.
