"Write" words using a newspaper or magazine to cut them out..like a ransom note!

Draw a small picture showing your word, then write a sentence about it!

Use half your spellings to write a question...then use the other half to answer them!

Write three words which rhyme with each spelling word.



### Bond, James Bond...

Create a code. Write your words in the code. Can someone else crack them?

e.g. a = □ b = ♦ c = ▲

### Synonym/Antonym

Synonym - means the same
