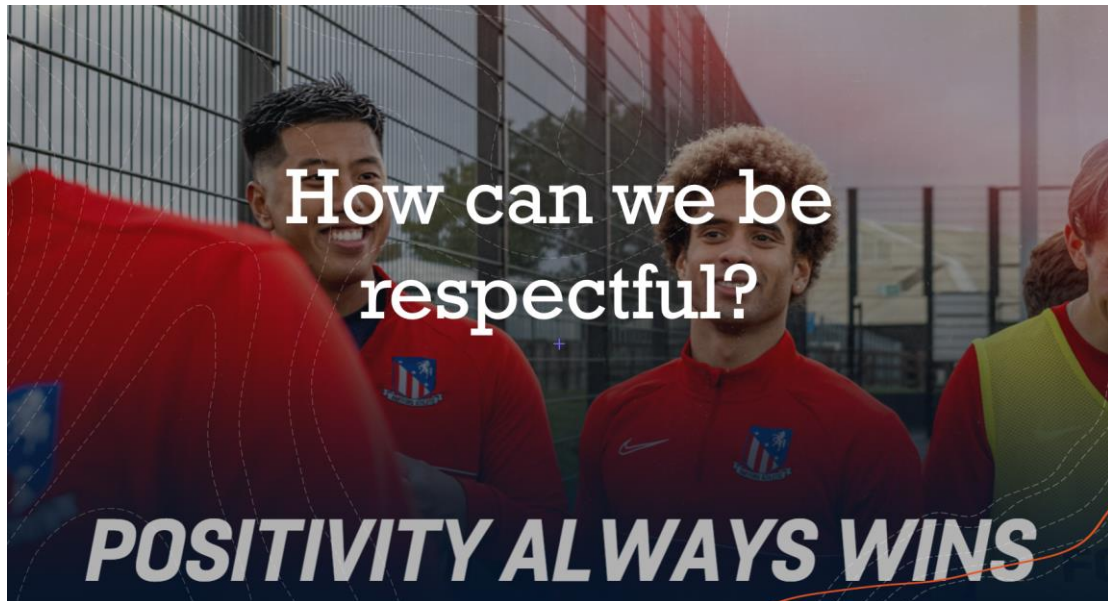


Emergency Paediatric First Aid Course
