(Vowels: a, e, i, o, u)



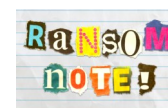
Like an Egyptian...

Write each letter of the word in a different colour to create a rainbow!



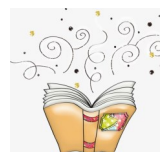
Let's be silly...
