Dear Parents/carers

What a busy week for the children this week.

It was lovely to see Mr and Mrs Whitechurch this week who came in to collect our old Collins Primary Maths books and also some out of date reading books, they were delighted to receive so many generous donations from you all and asked us to pass on their thanks. They will be leaving for Uganda tomorrow but will pop in to pick up the rest of the donations and money raised from the sale of coffee today. They will also be taking with them letters from pupils in year 5/6. They have promised to come into school on their return to talk to the children and share photographs of the school.

Preschool have had a very busy week. On Monday we went on a Senses Scavenger Hunt, finding items that were smooth, rough, noisy, round, yellow, a plant, smelly, long, man-made, soft, edible and red. On Tuesday we went to The Woods, where we built a real fire, toasted marshmallows and drank hot chocolate. On Wednesday we cooked Cheesy Pumpkin Biscuits and played in the shaving foam using our feet! And on Thursday we joined in with the Harvest Festival, singing two songs with Class 1.

Class 1 have been making fruit crumble with the apples they picked from the school grounds and Mrs Withers garden. They are very happy with the lovely new gate and have also been enjoying decorating their beautiful new bright coloured display boards, it has helped transform the classroom thank you so much to those that stayed to help put them up last Friday. They children have also been writing some lovely autumn poems for their new noticeboards.

We are excited to announce that a play house with a slide is being installed today and tomorrow, rubber matting will also be laid during half term so that it is ready for the children when they come back.

Class 2 have been making fossils, as well as learning about past, present and future. In Maths they have been learning all about weights and measures. They have also been rehearsing their play for today's Harvest Festival.

Class 3 and Year 4 have been busy rehearsing for their Harvest festival presentations and have been studying fractions in Maths. They are working hard learning their times tables; children should know all their tables confidently by the end of year 4. Our target this year is to ensure every child in years 4-6 has achieved this by Christmas. We really appreciate your support in helping your children learn this very important skill, some children find using online games and apps really helps with this.
