<p>Easy as ABC... Write all your words in alphabetical (ABC) order.</p> 	<p>Part of a whole... Write your words into different syllables using different colours!</p>  <p>Brown</p>	<p>On the other hand... Use the hand you don't usually write with to practise your spellings!</p> 	<p>In the spotlight... Write the consonants in one colour, vowels in the other. (Vowels: a, e, i, o, u)</p> 
<p>Like an Egyptian... Write your word in a pyramid</p> <p>py pyr pyra pyram pyrami pyramid</p>	<p>Your money or ... "Write" words using a newspaper or magazine to cut them out...like a ransom note!</p> 	<p>Come rain or shine... Write each letter of the word in a different colour to create a rainbow!</p> 	<p>Let's be silly ... Write a sentence which uses all of your words in it!</p> 
<p>Tell me a story... Draw a small picture showing your word, then write a sentence about it!</p> 	<p>Blowing bubbles... Write all your words in bubble writing!</p> 	<p>20 Questions... Use half your spellings to write a question... then use the other half to answer them!</p> 	<p>Rhyme Time... Write three words which rhyme with each spelling word.</p> 
<p>Bond, James Bond... Create a code. Write your words in the code. Can someone else crack them? e.g. a = o b = ♦ c = ▲</p>	<p>Synonym/Antonym Synonym - means the same Antonym - the opposite Write one of each for each of your words!</p> 	<p>That's backwards... Write your spelling words backwards!</p> 	<p>You're a joker... Write each word into a joke! Test them out on someone nearby...</p>
