Write all your words in alphabetical (ABC) order.



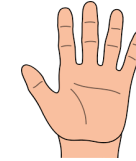
Part of a whole...

Write a sentence which uses **all** of your words in it!



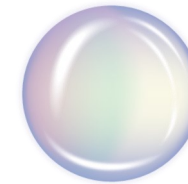
Tell me a story...
