This week, Preschool have been thinking about how they are all different. They listened to the stories of The Ugly Duckling and Brenda's Boring Egg. They made chocolate nests, and practised their cutting and size ordering skills. Outside they played hook-a-duck, ducks in shaving gel and the Duck, Duck, Swan game, as well as visiting the school playground and travelling on the train to Lanzarote!

Class 1 have written their letters to Father Christmas and special party invitations. They have been learning all about celebrations in other countries, and they had great fun in the woods using position and direction to find hidden elves.

Class 2 in Literacy they have enjoyed writing poems on resilience for a national competition. In science they have been looking at reflection as part of their topic on light. In maths the year 2's have been looking at directions using North, South, East and West, the year 3's have explored right angles and making quarter turns.

This week class 3 visited the solar farm in Canworthy Water and had a sustainable energy workshop back at school in the afternoon. The children, as always, made us very proud with their outstanding behaviour and impeccable manners, They had an amazing time taking part in a whole day's workshop. In Class 3 they have also been looking at compact subtraction in Maths. In Literacy they have been learning how to write a play script and practising for their school play. They were also very excited to receive their letters from their pen pals at the Father Omoding school.

In Maths, Year 4 have continued their work on decimals looking at the rules to follow, when rounding up or down and are now learning about weight; how to convert grams to kilograms and back again. In literacy they are writing poems on resilience for a National Competition.
