We worked in teams to celebrate our Number Day, it is always such a super atmosphere at Warbstow when the children work across classes and enjoy working with children they don't usually play and work with. The beauty of a small school! Small and mighty is the Warbstow way.

Times Table Rock Stars and NumBots

We are thrilled that our children in YR – Y2 now have access to a maths app – Numbots. It is a great way of ensuring children parctice their maths skills and embed key number facts. Please do log in at home and enjoy! Thank you to those of you that have done so already. Last week's newsletter had the log in information included.

The focus for our children in Y2-Y6 is Times Table Rockstars. This is a great way of practising our times tables. We have talked to the children this week about the importance of learning our times table facts before we practice. Year 3 and 4 have had specific guidance home around this. Year 2 are just starting on this journey and learning their 2, 5 and 10 times tables in school. Please please please learn the tables at home and practise and much as possible. You will have received last week a heat map for your child showing progress from October to February, we have analysed them all and it is great to see so many multiplication facts turning from red to orange to green. Facts in orange and red are 'sticky facts' and these are ones to focus on at home please. We notice how not knowing our times tables impacts our day to day maths learning. Ideally children should be recalling known facts (ones they know well) within 6 seconds – this doesn't give enough time to count along on fingers. This strategy is fine when first learning facts but we then need to be even more automatic. Thank you for your support.
