Dear Parents/carers

It was wonderful to see so many of you at parents evening on Wednesday. I know many of you who weren't able to make it, have already made alternative appointments with your class teacher. If you haven't yet been able to do so, please see you class teacher to arrange a convenient time.

Pre-School have watched a PowerPoint about Remembrance Day, used hand prints to make a poppy wreath, drawn a picture of a poppy, and walked up to the Warbstow War Memorial to place their wreath. They joined Reception in the Woods singing number songs and enjoyed playing Hide and Seek, and pretending to be giants.

Class 1 have been doing some amazing handwriting, writing all about remembrance Sunday. They have also had great fun testing Jellies. In Maths they have been learning all about multiplication and division.

Class 2 have been looking at aerial photos in Geography and looking at Warbstow and London. They have also been continuing with their 5 times tables and club 99.

Year 4 have begun ordering decimals in Maths. In Literacy they have written newspaper reports about a 'Car wash catastrophe.' Mrs Dyer has been especially impressed this week with the children's progress with their times tables. Class 3 have been looking at negative numbers and the difference between a positive and negative integer. In Literacy they have been writing a non-chronical report about "Fantastical Machines!". All the children have been doing really well with their swimming and finally all the children have been getting on well drinking plenty of water in their lessons and taking great care of their bottles.

This week, 4 of our Year 5 boys Finlay, Archie, Harry and Tom entered the North Cornwall Swimming Gala. They made us very proud, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> place with a total of 2 minutes and 43 seconds out of 16 schools. Absolutely fantastic work boys.
