Curriculum Intent for KS2 Outdoor Learning

By the end of KS2, children will be able to select tools / skills for purpose. Some will have the confidence to demonstrate and show others how to use tolls / skills safely. They will recognise the links that outdoor learning has to the curriculum and use this knowledge in their work in a variety of curriculum areas.
